Captain Wrubluski enlisted in the Marine Corps in November of 1994 and immediately departed for Recruit Training aboard Marine Corps Recruit Depot, Parris Island, South Carolina. Upon graduation in February of 1995, Private Wrubluski was meritoriously promoted to the rank of Private First Class (PFC). From that time up to May 12, 2010 he continued to earn meritorious promotions through the ranks, was assigned to numerous Battalions and Platoons, deployed to Afghanistan, Japan, and Australia to name a few, and attended over 30 military courses focusing primarily on weapons, explosives, anti-terrorism, and force protection. Capt. Wrubluski has also attended numerous resident and non-resident leadership and professional military education courses, including Expeditionary Warfare School and Amphibious Warfare School.
