Tee off on the world's best courses, rain or shine, on our state-of-the-art Full Swing golf simulators that imitate real golf on a variety of world-renowned courses. Located on the 5th floor of the 30 South Michigan building, our simulators offer unmatched accuracy as well as feedback about speed, spin and flight trajectory of the ball. The Club's two simulators offer play on 51 courses as well as a practice feature. There are two sets of clubs for right-handed players, one set for left-handed players, one women's set and a few junior clubs. Members may bring their own clubs via the back-of-house elevators and Club storage is not permitted. The access code to unlock the door is 2840. The same code 2840 is needed to get back into the Club from the 5th floor.

HOW DO I GET TO THE GOLF CENTER?

The Golf Center is located on the 5th floor of the 30 South Michigan Avenue (30 South) building. The simplest path of travel is via the elevator or stairs in the 30 South building, either beside the Member Workspace on the 6th floor or in the Living Room on the 7th floor.

The most direct route from outside is the 30 South entrance. You can also access the Golf Center from the main Michigan Avenue clubhouse through the back of the house on the 5th floor. The Golf Center phone extension is x391.

IS THERE A FEE?

There is no member fee to use the Golf Center unless you are using it to host a group of six or more. Athletic daily fee applies for all guests.
